Please note that the membership voted in a change to article 4, section 9 of the bylaws at this year's annual meeting. The spirit of the change was to protect board members & officers from any increased personal liability from volunteering on the board, and is consistent with how other local volunteer organizations are set-up. We also have a group set up on Yahoo which is a great way to communicate with other Two Lake residents. This is a central email list which makes it easy for members to email each other about Two Lake issues – whether it's club news, town or environmental information that affects the lakes, or asking for recommendations for service people.

If you're concerned about security issues, we have taken these precautionary measures:

- When someone joins the group, yahoo sends me an email – I must approve each application – so only Two Lake members will be in the group.
- We are not explicitly listed as a group on yahoo, so you have to know the name of our group – twolakeclub – to view the site.

email, we ask that you use this address judiciously.

## Beach and Boat Rules

Enjoy our lakes and beach but you must comply with our beach and boat rules for everyone's safety and for the health of the lakes. These rules are listed on the Two Lake web site – [www.twolakeclub.org](http://www.twolakeclub.org). Any violations of these rules should be reported to an Officer or Director of the Two Lake Club.

In addition to the rules listed on the web site, please note:

- **Swimming** is AT YOUR OWN RISK! Also, jumping or diving off the float is not allowed.
- NEVER let your **children** play unattended.
- All **guests** must be accompanied by a resident member in good standing of The Two Lake Club. Please don't let your **friends** bring their boats to the lakes. Also, make sure that people doing work on your house or property understand that they can't bring gear to the lakes.
- The **gate** at the entrance to the beach area must be kept locked. A new lock with a new combination will be used this year.
- Please **do not dig** in the sand, Large holes have been left on the beach which is not only unsightly but could be dangerous. There is no tide to smooth out the sand that should be considered a decorative top dressing. Please use the sandbox provided.
